Fiscal Updates: Amendments and Claiming Funding



Amendments

- ❖ Applications do not need to be amended if there is no significant change in program objectives or if the change is less than or equal to \$100 or 10% of the line (whichever is greater) but must not exceed \$10,000.

Reimbursements

- ❖ Please remember to submit all reimbursement requests monthly. Only request funds used and do not submit reimbursement requests for funds that are not yet used, and/ or grantees do not plan to use.

Fiscal Updates: Reminders

- ❖ If applications are returned for edits, please review the comment section to understand what is being requested. Do not let the application sit for any reason. Grantees will not be able to use funding as desired until applications are DESE fiscally approved.
- ❖ When contacting Cashay regarding issues or concerns, be as clear and descriptive as possible, including the fiscal year and accurate fund code. If there is an error message, also include a screenshot. This allows Cashay to effectively support and address all concerns in a timely manner.
- ❖ Do not miss deadlines or wait until the last minute to complete tasks and address action items. Programs run the risk of forfeiting funding with no option for funding to be returned.
- ❖ If there are changes and/or concerns that affect the ability to spend all funding, contact Cashay ASAP.



Fiscal Updates: FC 461A-B

School Year FY26 Early College Planning Grant FC461A-B

- ❖ FC 461 Option A Grantees: Applications that are still pending and not submitted to the Superintendent/ Chief Executive Approval step by **Friday, January 9th**, will forfeit funding.
- ❖ FC461 Option B Grantees: The Office of Early College is currently reviewing all submissions. All Applications are due **Monday, January 12th**, and must be at the Superintendent /Chief Executive Approval Step by the deadline.
- ❖ Please note that this is the final extension, and if not completed, funding will be forfeited with no opportunity for funding to be returned.


