

# Fiscal Updates: Mandatory Fiscal Mid-Year Review



## ❖ Please come prepared to review the following:

- Updates on current spending and budget changes
- Pending action items in GEMS
- Completed and updates on reimbursements to date
- If all funding will be spent by June 30th, or will additional time be needed. If additional time is needed, I will go over the PAC process.

## Use of funds during the summer (PAC)

- ❖ If programs would like to use funds beyond June 30th or need additional time to spend all funds, programs have the option to PAC funds during July 1 – August 31, 2026. Come prepared with projected amounts for spending until June 30th and amounts from July 1 to August 31, 2026. **FINAL numbers will be required via a shared spreadsheet by April 6th.**
- ❖ Please note that if programs do not complete the mid-year review funds will expire June 30, 2026, with no option to use these funds during the summer.

# Fiscal Updates: Amendments and Claiming Funding

## Amendments

- ❖ Applications do not need to be amended if there is no significant change in program objectives or if the change is less than or equal to \$100 or 10% of the line (whichever is greater) but must not exceed \$10,000.


## Reimbursements

- ❖ Please remember to submit all reimbursement requests monthly or at least quarterly. Only request funds used and do not submit reimbursement requests for funds that are not yet used, and/ or grantees do not plan to use. Please note, reimbursements are now capped. Therefore, if you see a MAX reimbursement that less than the full allocation, it is only because the full allocation is not available for reimbursement. The full allocation will be available by the end of the grant period (June 30<sup>th</sup>).



# Fiscal Updates: Reminders

- ❖ If applications are returned for edits, please review the comment section to understand what is being requested. Do not let the application sit for any reason. Grantees will not be able to use funding as desired until applications are DESE fiscally approved.
- ❖ When contacting Cashay regarding issues or concerns, be as clear and descriptive as possible, including the fiscal year and accurate fund code. If there is an error message, also include a screenshot. This allows Cashay to effectively support and address all concerns in a timely manner.
- ❖ Do not miss deadlines or wait until the last minute to complete tasks and address action items. Programs run the risk of forfeiting funding with no option for funding to be returned.
- ❖ If there are changes and/or concerns that affect the ability to spend all funding, contact Cashay ASAP.
